Franz, Dan. and Eli Hartig, were three teamsters well known all over the north before they came to the west side. They were pioneers on some of the nor-west tracks, and often had to do long stages without water for their bullocks. Franz had a very intelligent bullock, which he always worked as a single leader with a short yoke and trace chains. This animal 'used to answer the word of com-mand like a well-trained soldier.
